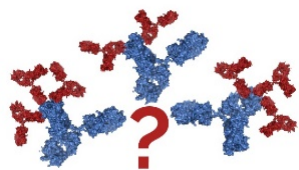

Question	Answer
Thank you Jim for the nice presentation. Do you think that the RNAscope technique will help us with validation of antibodies in IHC?	Yes, although any technique that involves catalytic (enzymatic-based) signal amplification can lead to non-linearity versus techniques in which the signal is stoichiometric.
How much variability in immunostaining in IHC do you see using the various available fixation technologies?	In our hands this very much depends on the antibody and target. Some labeling is remarkably unperturbed by changes in fixation conditions, which one can only imagine have profound effects on antigen conformational state, protein-protein interactions, etc. However, other antibodies are remarkably sensitive.
